The Clinic Project has been completed!

Thank you for your outstanding support to the Tanzanian Children's Project (TCP, Inc.). With your support, the Malowa Medical Clinic has been **completed and is now open**.

Hard to believe, but after 5 and ½ years of effort, the Malowa Medical Clinic, located in a rural area in the foothills of Mount Kilimanjaro has been completed. Over \$75,000 was raised by TCP and donated to the Catholic Diocese of Moshi in Tanzania for the construction, outfitting, and staffing of the Malowa Medical Clinic. The Clinic has been turned over to a local religious order, the Adorer Missionary Sisters of the Poor, who will own and operate it. The clinic meets Tanzanian government requirements and been accredited by the government. The staff is treating patients.



With the clinic project completed, TCP is turning its attention to **other activities** which will help children in Tanzania. TCP efforts will be focused on providing support to existing institutions instead of constructing new facilities.

The TCP Board of Directors thanks the Knights for all the time donated and the money contributed to our projects to help the people in Tanzania.
